About 60 members of the Ontario Society of Professional Engineers (OSPE) from across the province met in Toronto on Saturday, November 11th, 2001, along with OSPE board members and staff, for the new advocacy body's first Annual General Assembly. The results of OSPE Member's Survey 2000 were presented and reviewed. A total of 3,341 members completed the questionnaire. Five issues were most important to members. Three of the five issues related to the public's perception and the status of the profession (need to enhance the profile of engineering, need to increase the public's appreciation of the profession and need to address the misuse of the term "Engineer"), while two focused primarily on compensation (compensation and salary level for engineers, and mobility within Canada and the U.S.A.). The day-long program was a great success, providing members the opportunity to discuss the issues, determine priorities, provide suggestions, and share information and different perspectives.

As individuals, many Professional Engineers already engage directly or indirectly in activities that reflect positively on Engineering in general, from excelling in their field of Science and Technology, to contributing to the Economic or social development of the community, or perhaps volunteering in activities at local schools or non-profit organizations.

Call For Nominations, Annual General Meeting

The nominating committee of the York Chapter PEO is accepting nominations of the Chapter Directorate. Pertinent sections of the Chapter by-laws are as follows:

Article 4

1. The Directorate shall be not less than six (6) members and not more than twelve (12) members. A quorum shall be five (5).
2. A nominating committee comprised of one (1) member of the current directorate and two (2) members at large shall be appointed by the current executive. A notice shall be sent annually to all members requesting nominations for the directorate. The nominations must be received by the committee two (2) weeks prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM). Nominations must bear the signature of two (2) nominators and the nominee. A nominee must be a member of the chapter.
3. A slate of candidates including all those properly nominated shall be proposed by the nominating committee for presentation at the AGM.

4. The directorate shall be elected at the AGM from the proposed slate of candidates.

5. The directorate shall meet immediately after the AGM to elect the officers from its members.

6. The officers shall be Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer. The immediate Past Chair shall be an office ex officio. The office of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined.

All nominations must be received by the committee two (2) weeks prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM), at the address below -by Jan. 27th, 2001.

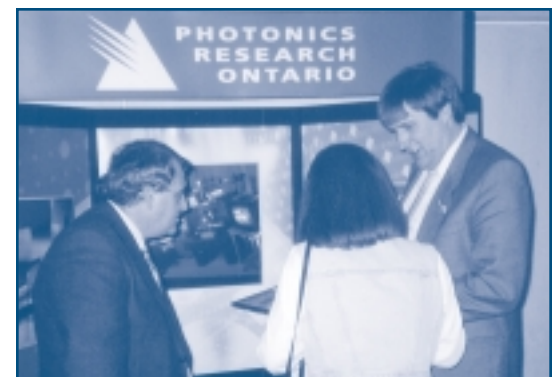

Laser Machining

The technical seminar on Laser Machining was held on November 15, 2000. The title was "Light is the Tool of the New Millennium" presented by Dr. Marc Nantel of Photonics Research Ontario. 31 people attended the seminar. Part of the presentation, featured a demonstration of using a low power laser for marking wood samples as souvenirs for the attendees.

The seminar was very informative and was followed by an informal discussion of the various possible applications of laser micro-machining in the industry.
