Call For Executive Nominations, Annual General Meeting

The nominating committee of the York Chapter PEO is accepting nominations for the Chapter Directorate. The chapter executives are volunteer members operating the functions of the chapter. There is no direct monetary compensation, except for certain out of pocket expenses. The elected executives are required to attend monthly meetings, and participate in events/functions. Additional time commitment will vary upon the particular role/function of each position.

Article 4 of the Chapter by-laws is as follows:

- 1. The Directorate shall be not less than six (6) members and not more than twelve (12) members. A quorum shall be five (5).
- 2. A nominating committee comprised of one (1) member of the current directorate and two (2) members at large shall be appointed by the current executive. A notice shall be sent annually to all members requesting nominations for the directorate. The nominations must be received by the committee two (2) weeks prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM). Nominations must bear the signature of two (2) nominators and the nominee. A nominee must be a member of the chapter.
- 3. A slate of candidates including those properly nominated shall be proposed by the nominating committee for presentation at AGM.

- 4. The directorate shall be elected at the AGM from the proposed slate of candidates.
- 5. The directorate will meet immediately after the AGM to elect the officers from its members.
- 6. The officers shall be Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer. The immediate Past Chair shall be an office ex-officio. The office of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined.

Jennifer's efforts have allowed us to verify the email addresses of over 1000 of our members, and add many more to our list. We are now able to reach 53% of our members by email, a vast improvement from the 15% in 2003!
