### Call For Executive Nominations, Annual General Meeting

The nominating committee of the York Chapter PEO is accepting nominations for the Chapter Directorate. The chapter executives are volunteer members who donate timeand effort to participate in the operations and functions of the chapter. There is no direct monetary compensation, except for certain out of pocket expenses. The elected executives are required to attend monthly meetings, and participate in certain events/functions. Additional timecommitment will vary upon the particular role/function of each position.

Article 4 of the Chapter by-laws is as follows:

- 1. The Directorate shall be not less than six (6) members and not more than twelve (12) members. A quorum shall be five (5).
- 2. A nominating committee comprised of one (1) member of the current directorate and two (2) members at large shall be appointed by the current executive. A notice shall be sent annually to all members requesting nominations for the directorate. The nominations must be received by the committee two (2) weeks prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM). Nominations must bear the signature of two (2) nominators and the nominee. A nominee must be a member of the chapter.
- A slate of candidates including all those properly nominated shall be proposed by the nominating committee for presentation at the AGM.

- 4. The directorate shall be elected at the AGM from the proposed slate of candidates.
- 5. The directorate will meet immediately after the AGM to elect the officers from its members.
- 6. The officers shall be Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer. The immediate Past Chair shall be an office ex-officio. The office of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined.

#### **Toyota Plant Tour**

n November 18, 2003, 23 engineers joined the York Chapter Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada (TMMC) Plant Tour, located in Cambridge.

It started with a video presentation of the tour with safety information and Toyota Kaisen (continuous improvement) methodology. Then we rode on three motorized

vehicles embarking on adventurous tour of its production shops including the power train, stamping, body welding, and final assembly operations. TMMC was opened on May 26, 1989 It now manufactures Corolla, Matrix and the 2004 Lexus RX330, which is the first Lexus ever to be built outside Japan. The current capacity has reached 250,000 cars per year. Everybody was happy about the tour, and learned about the Kaisen principle.
